The World Bank has already provided Kyrgyzstan with financial support of EUR 22 million to assist improvement and modernisation of the sector. Foreign investments play an important role for Kyrgyzstan in developing solutions to streamline energy usage and maintenance equipment as well as hydro power resources.

During the visit you will be brought close to potential projects. Additionally, with B2B meetings and a roundtable conference we aim to find partners and customers suitable for your business.
